Welcome to our new series on the gospel of Mark! We'll be journeying through the first nine chapters between now and Lent (with a short break for Advent).

Mark was the first to write an account of Jesus' life and through dynamic and compelling stories he wants to convey who Jesus is and what he came to do. This is the gospel that speaks most about the *Kingdom of God* so many of the talks have either 'king' or 'kingdom' in the title. Mark also focuses on *the way people respond to Jesus* - a challenge as we think about this in our own context. Then there is the question Jesus asks in 8:29: *'But what about you? Who do you say I am?'*

My prayer is that Mark will help us to answer this for ourselves as the series unfolds over the coming weeks. Enjoy!
